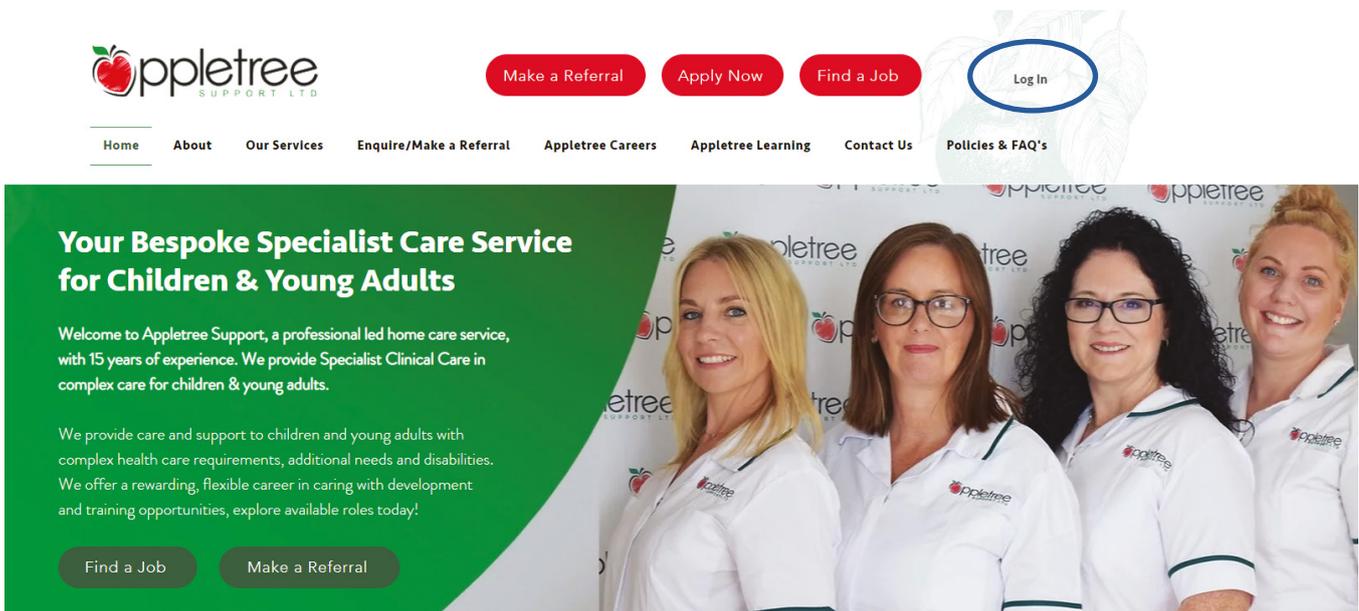


How to become an Appletree website member



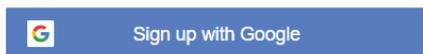
1. Head over to our website www.appletreesupport.co.uk and click on the login button:

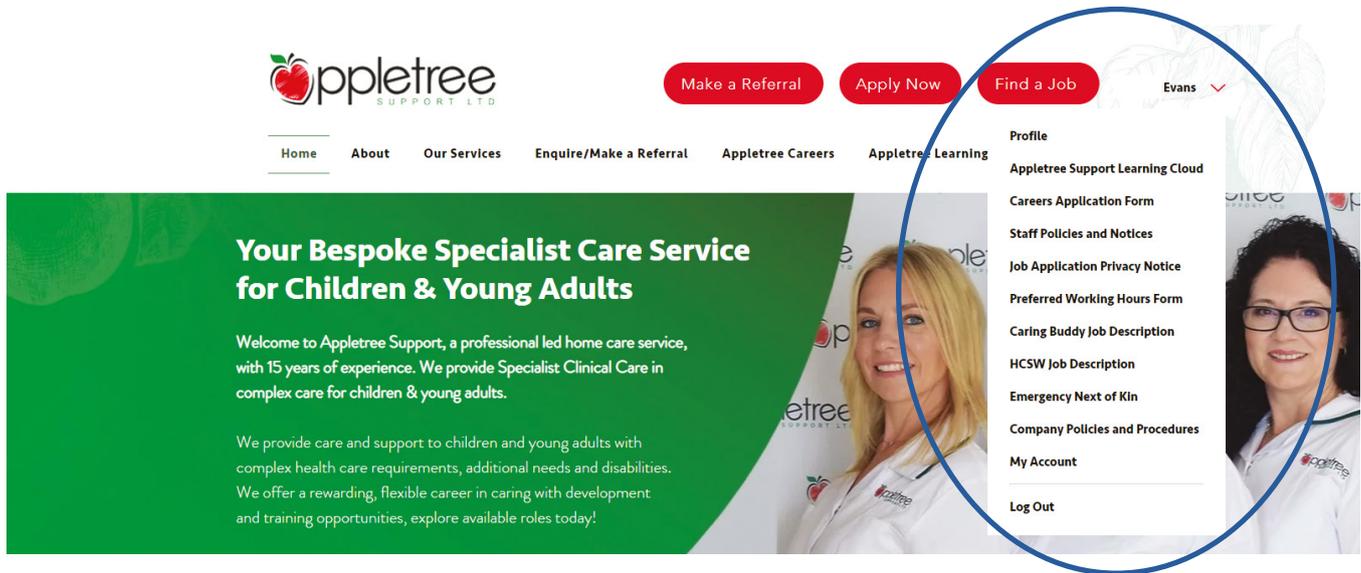

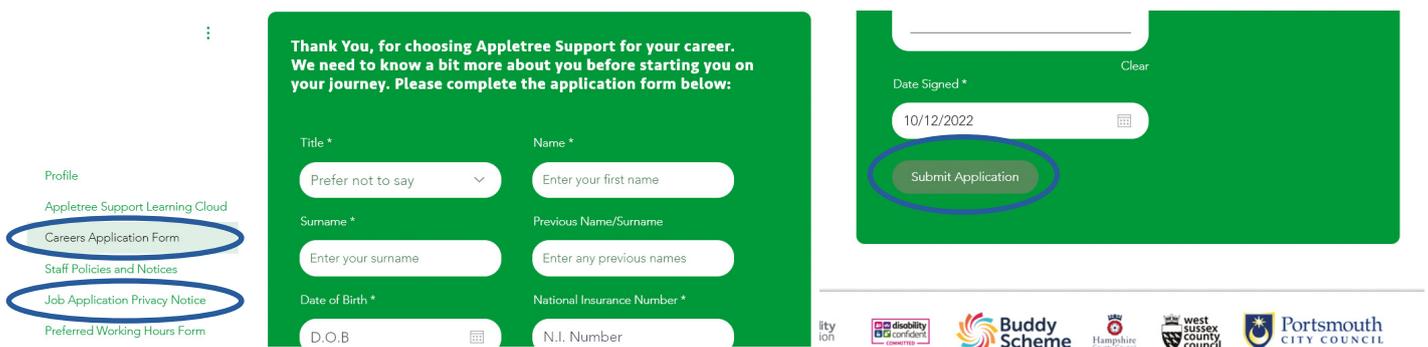
